 - It's very important to always reference the Global Address List in the email client when you send email > "Directory" in WebMail or the "Address Book" in Outlook.

 - You will find all Users with current contact information
 - When you Search users, it will query
 - Cleaning up your Personal Address Book "Contacts"
 - 've noticed a lot of old employees and non-existent email addresses in your "My Contacts" folders. It's important that we take a moment to clean out this folder and organize them in a manner that makes sense for you and your intent to use them.
 - For those of you who desire to have updated contacts on your mobile devices and tablets, I am currently working on a solution to share the Global Address list so you can see them in "My Contacts". This will allow you to see an updated Address list on your mobile devices. I'll keep you posted.
