SUNDAY WORSHIP ACTIVITIES FROM BUMC KIDS MARCH 29, 2020

READ

Job 42:1-2

Then Job answered the Lord: I know you can do anything. No plan of yours can be opposed successfully. (CEB)

Job 42:10

Then the Lord changed Job's fortune when Job prayed for his friends, and the Lord doubled all of Job's earlier possessions. (CEB)

Jesus told us that two most important commandments are loving God and loving others (Matthew 22:37-39), and we see Job do this as we read the final chapter of his story. In verses 1 and 2 (after God has asked Job all kinds of questions about who created the universe), Job replies to God, "I know that you can do anything." What a statement of faith! By saying this, Job shows love for God by expressing trust and understanding. And we can do this too! Any time we praise God for who God is, we are loving God.

We also learned that Job's bad situation changed when he started to pray for his friends. These are the same friends that told Job he might as well give up on God. When Job showed love to his friends, God blessed him.

This week, we hope you will remember these two important things: that we can love God by showing faith and trust in God's power, and that we can also love God by loving and praying for our friends.

DISCUSS

Look up Ephesians 3:20. What do you know God can do?

What do you need to surrender to God this week?

How can you pray for others this week?

Loving God, thank you for what you have taught us from the story of Job. Help us to be strong in our faith like Job. Help us to pray for our friends like Job. Help us remember who you are and all that you have done.

What you will need: A flower bulb or seed Soil Glass or see through Container Water Watering Can or Pitcher

INSTRUCTIONS

- Make sure your glass container is cleaned and that you ar able to see through it!
- You can do this with a bulb or seed, or a flower that has already bloomed!
- Read your seed instructions (or look them up online) to make sure you give your plant the correct amount of soil/water and that it is getting the right amount of sunlight.
- Every time you look at your bulb flower, remember that God can do anything far beyond what we can see!
