PROGRAMMING

STUDENT MINISTRY IN THE AM (SM AM)

Zundays at 9:45 a.m.

Sunday mornings are often a great way to experience worship within a multigenerational service and then focus with peers to expand our understandings of God and our church. During the 9:45 Sunday School hour, we encourage students to engage in a class that allows them to expand their head knowledge of God through biblical study and their heart knowledge of God in community with others. SUNDAY EVENING PROGRAMS SCHEDULE 6TH GRADE CONFIRMATION (FALL SEMESTER)

Zundays, 3 - 4:45 p.m.

Confirmation is an opportunity for 6th grade students to claim their faith as their own. During a semester-long class students will learn the basics of faith and theology, as well as United Methodist and Christian history. This class concludes with the opportunity for each student to confirm their faith and join the church, as well as a chance to be baptized. Confirmation has a combination of large group teaching by one of our clergy or student ministers and time for small groups. Confirmation, while a large milestone in one's faith journey, is not a finish line. Rather it's one part of the journey we hope to continue with each student throughout their time in BUMCSM.

Confirmation is offered every Fall semester for 6th grade students; if you are a student who missed Confirmation, we also offer an accelerated class on Sunday mornings in the Fall.

MIDDLE SCHOOL SUNDAY NIGHTS

Middle School worship offers a variety of interactive elements that fit the unique spiritual journey for 6th-8th grade. Gathering in the Pit, students experience community through group games, hands-on activities, interactive worship, and a message. This is an exciting time and space for students to get plugged into the ministry and deepen a journey of following Christ. After the teaching, we offer smaller Discipleship Groups for students to connect on a deeper level with their peers and their leaders.

HIGH SCHOOL SUNDAY NIGHTS

For our high school students, we offer space where students encounter our living God. We call this time and place Tabernacle Worship. When we meet in the Tabernacle, we gather to focus on deepening our spiritual walk with Christ through games, singing, missional offering through Joy Buckets, teaching, and personal reflection. After worship, students have the opportunity to join a Discipleship Group by grade where they will engage with peers and leaders to experience accountability, support, and response steps to help with their faith journey.

Big Events are fun-filled nights that exist so that we can fulfill a part of our core values (Community, Discipleship, and Missional Living). We will have different events each semester, for example, Silent Disco, Skate Night, and Missional Living Night.



YOUTH ORCHESTRA

We are so excited to debut BUMC's third year of Youth Orchestra. Designed for 6th through 12th grade students, the three-week "sessions" are designed to share music with our congregation. Each session consists of learning hymns, praise songs, and relatable themes that will allow us to grow musically, socially, and spiritually. Youth Orchestra is a fabulous way to use God-given gifts, praise His name, connect all who participate in faith through music, and share with others in ministry throughout the church! There are three "sessions" per semester with a two-week break between sessions. No audition is necessary, so come on Sunday nights from 4-4:45 p.m. in the Sanctuary with your instrument in hand, open heart, joyful spirit, ready to make music with your peers and friends!
